



### Business Incentive Assistance

The Fort Myers Regional Partnership, Lee County's Economic Development Office, provides information on Florida incentive programs such as sales tax refunds and exemptions, Incumbent Worker Training, Quick Response Training, and Enterprise Zone. Lee County programs such as Job Opportunity Program (LCJOP) for high-wage jobs are also available to locating or expanding target industries.

### Employee Training & Recruitment Assistance

The Fort Myers Regional Partnership, Lee County's Economic Development Office, acts as a liaison between businesses and local education and training providers. We also partner with the Workforce Development Board of Southwest Florida, and Career and Service Centers, and can assist with obtaining state grants for training.

### Site Selection Assistance

Working closely with area landowners, developers and brokers, the Fort Myers Regional Partnership, Lee County's Economic Development Office, maintains a database of available industrial, warehouse and office buildings, business parks and freestanding sites.
